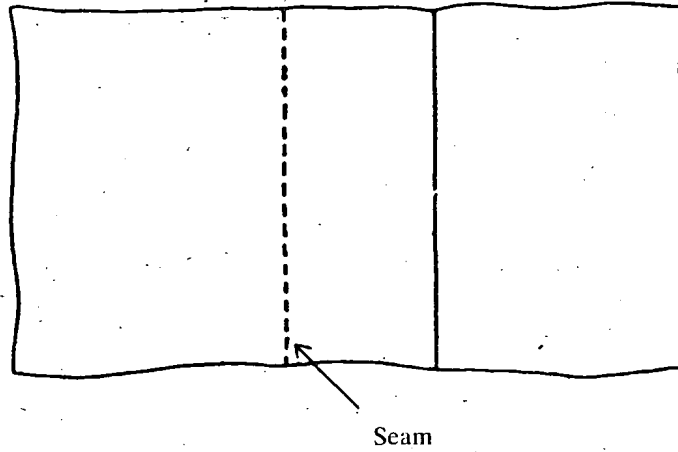
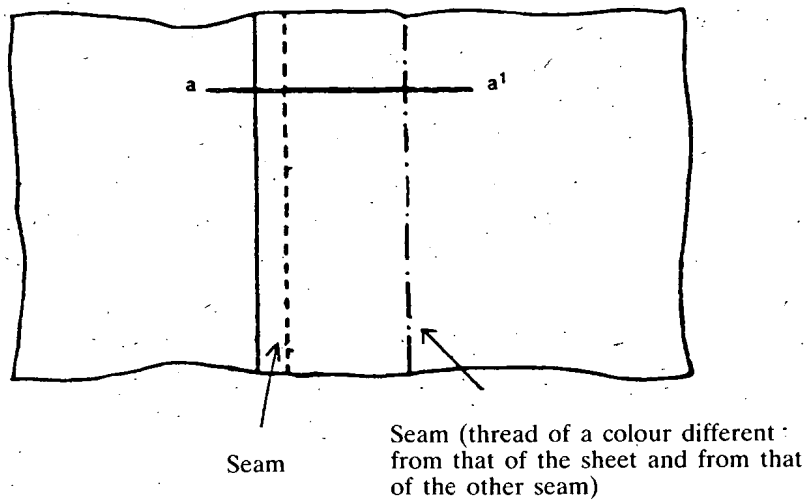

Sheet made of several pieces sewn together

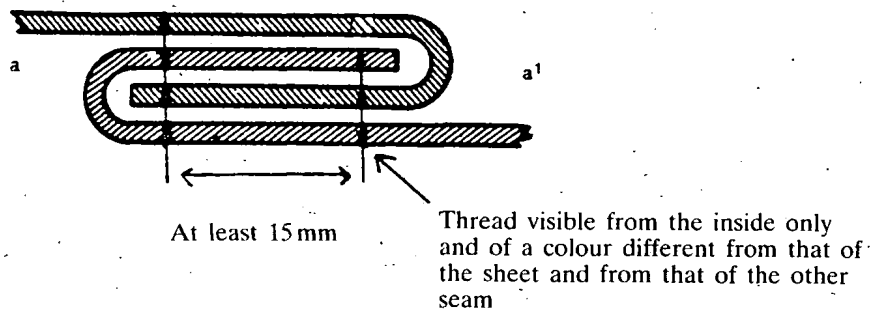
Outside view



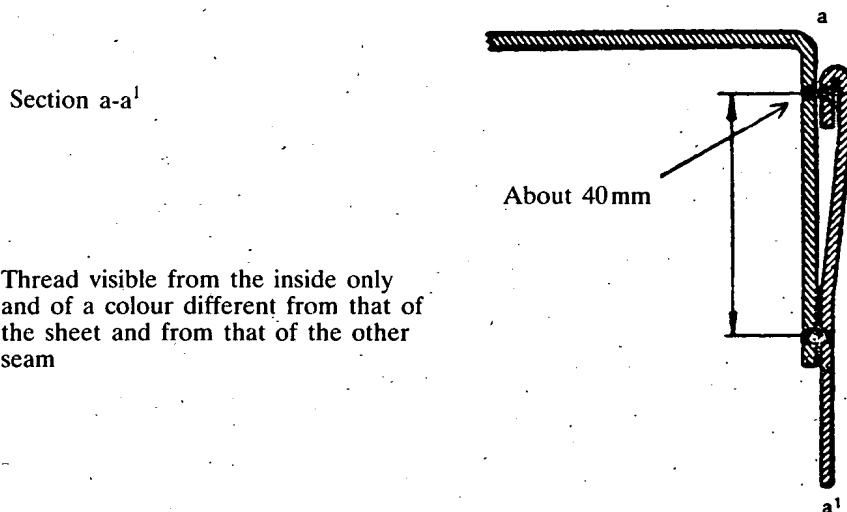
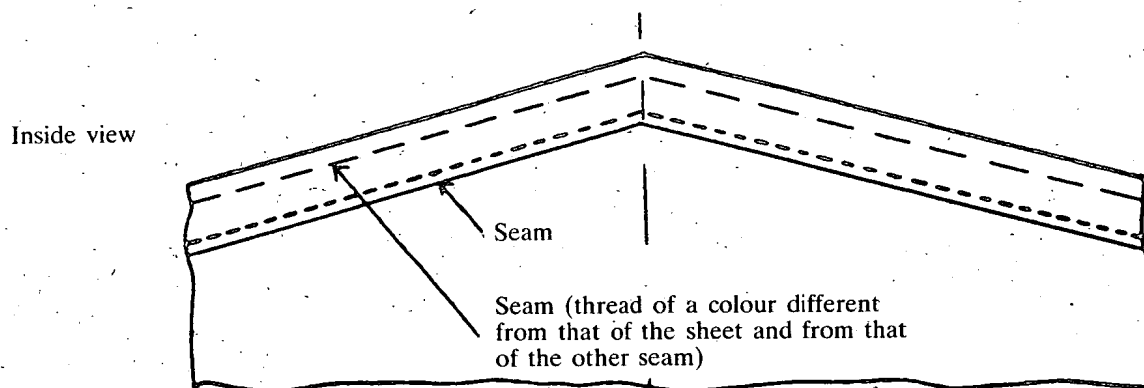
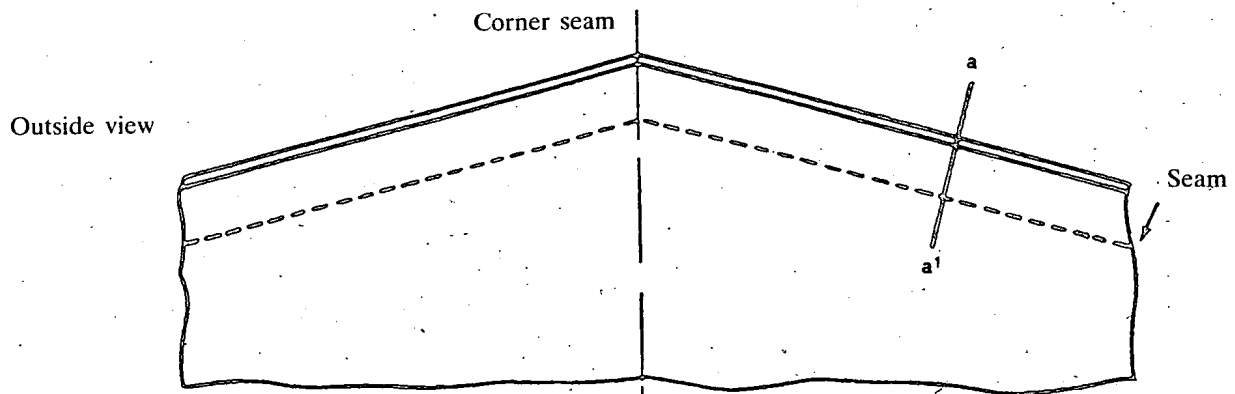
Inside view

Double flat seam



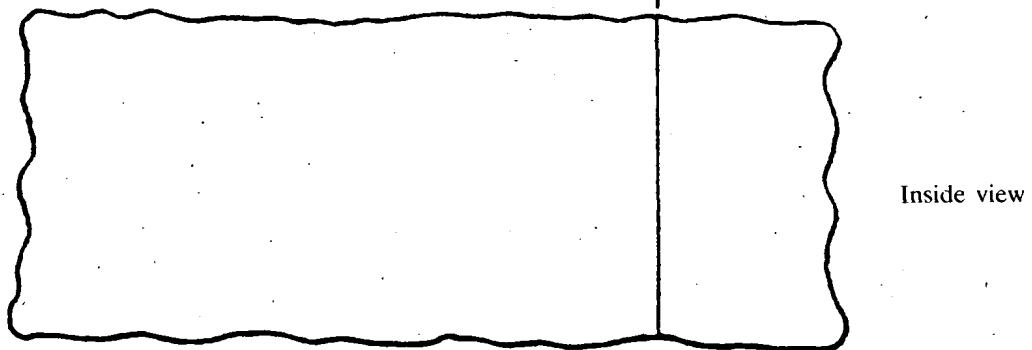
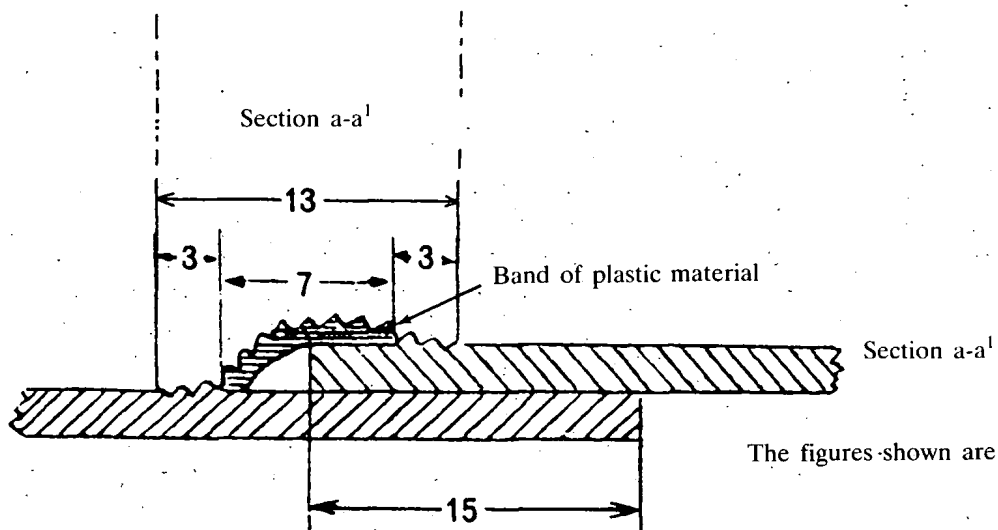
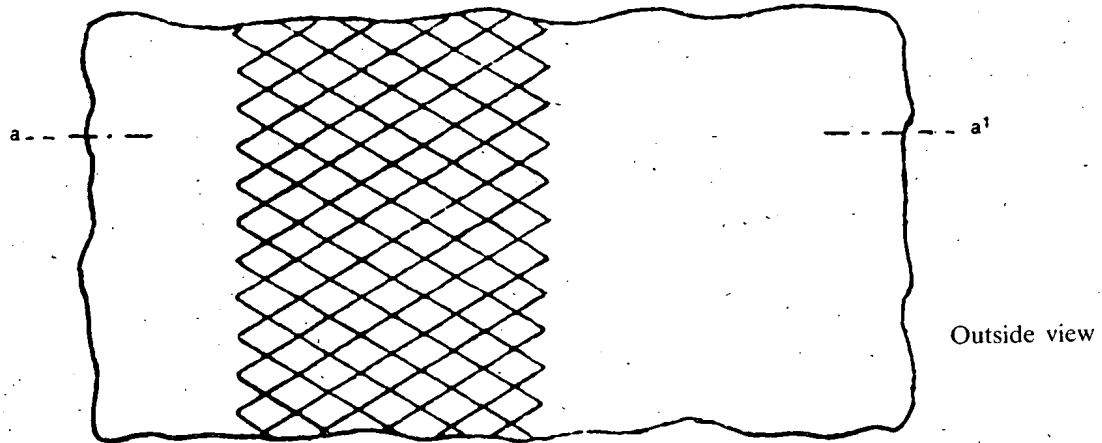
Sketch No 2

seam

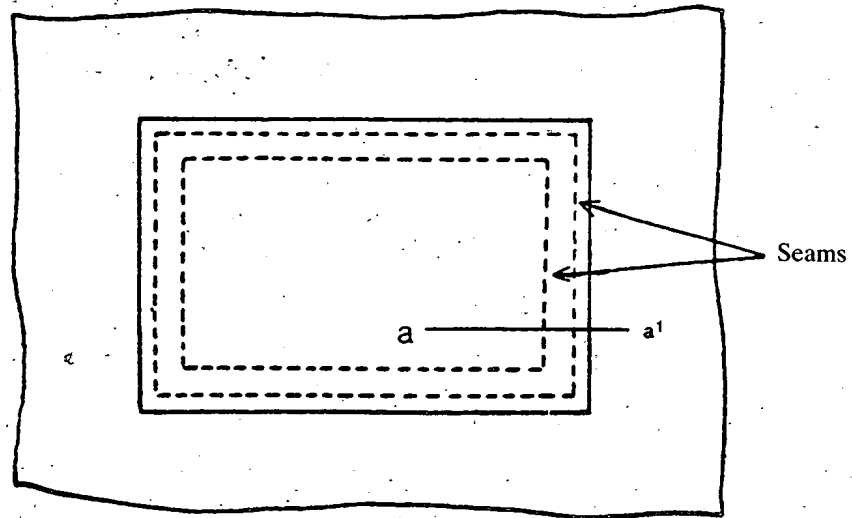

Sheet made of several pieces welded together

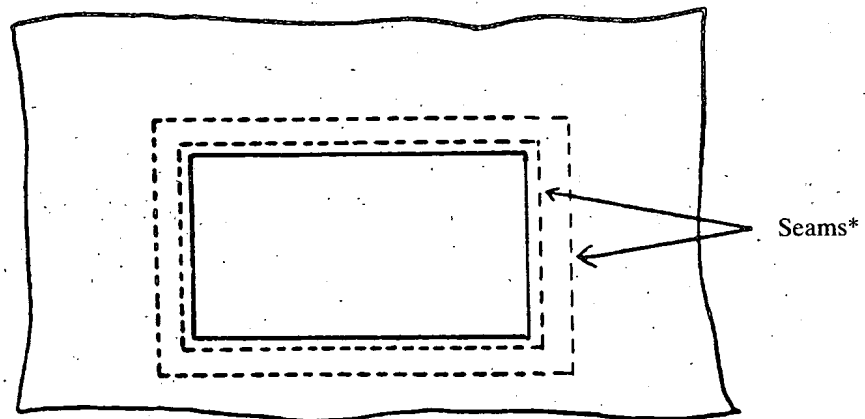

Repair of the sheet

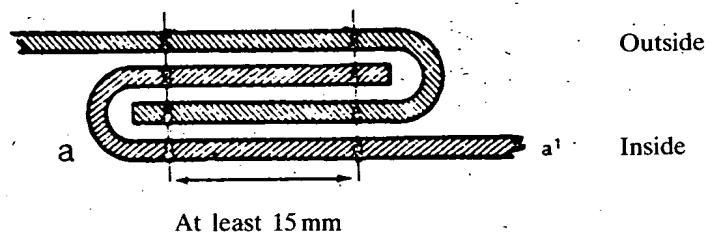

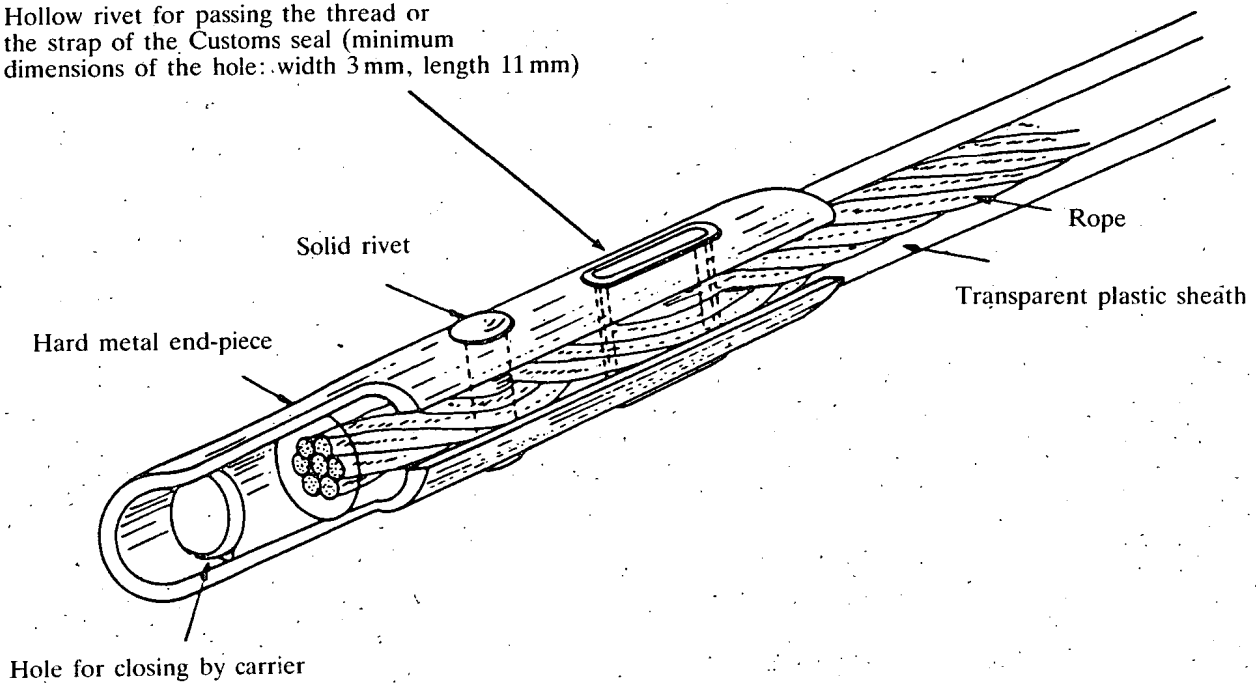


* Threads visible from the inside shall be of a colour different from that of the threads visible from the outside and from that of the sheet.
